## Coaches Code of Conduct



**ALL RSC COACHES AND ASSISTANT COACHES** are expected to exhibit the highest standard of conduct while acting in that capacity. The following minimal standards of conduct will be enforced by RSC.

A coach or assistant coach shall:

1. Demonstrate a positive attitude toward players, parents, coaches, referees and spectators.
2. Make no denigrating remarks to opposing players, coaches, spectators or referees.
3. Role-model good sportsmanship. No ill-tempered behavior will be tolerated.
4. Do not smoke or consume alcoholic beverages during soccer practices or games or in the presence of the players at an RSC activity.
5. Take proper action necessary to ensure that the conduct of the players on his/her team is appropriate at practices, games and RSC activities.
6. Exhibit cooperation with other coaches, Director of Coaching, Executive Board and RSC policies.

Failure to comply with the foregoing Code of Conduct will result in written notice by the Director of Coaching or the Executive Board. If the conduct continues, then the possibility of termination of the coach's contract can be determined by the RSC Executive Board. Prior to any decision regarding the termination of a coach's contract, the coach will be given an opportunity to present his/her position to the RSC Review Board.
