A player is considered rostered until an official drop form has been received by the registrar, however, the player will be responsible for club fees and accrued expenses..

Exception: if a player moves out of state prior to Nov 1st, the club fees will be reduced to \$100 in addition to the non-refundable registration fee, however, the player will be responsible for all additional expenses accrued while with the team .

Players that do not meet the commitment deadlines may forfeit his/her eligibility to play in the team selected and/or club directed tournaments. The head coach reserves the right to fill his/her spot with a guest player or another club member.

If an active rostered player that has committed to a tournament cannot attend and a shadow rostered player or another active club player fills his/her spot, the substituting player will **NOT** be charged for the tournament registration fees. The substituting player will be only charged for individual player fees and for coach’s expenses. If the active rostered player’s spot is not filled, that player will still be responsible for the coach’s expenses. If a club player is asked to play on another club team (example: blue team player asked to play for gold team) the player would be charged for their portion of expenses.

Non-club guest players will not be charged for tournament registration fee or for the coach’s expenses. The non-club guest player will be responsible for individual player fees and his/her travel expenses. *(A non-club guest player is only eligible to guest play for one indoor and one outdoor tournament per year.)*

The tournament entry/player fees and estimated coach travel reimbursements should be charged by the team treasurer and are payable prior to the club paying for them.

RSC has provided for three exceptions allowing an active rostered player to be released from his/her financial commitment and tournament expenses:

- 1.A death in the family.
- 2.A serious injury preventing him/her from playing. *(This needs to be verified by physician who is not related to the player.)*
- 3.A serious illness preventing him/her from playing. *(This needs to be verified by physician who is not related to the player.)*

A player may return from an injury or illness with verification from a physician stating the player is in good health and able to participate. *(This release needs to be provided by a physician who is not related to the player.)*
