acknowledge that I (we) understand and agree to the following commitments of finances and
time to the Rushmore Soccer Club Inc (RSC) for the stated seasonal year.

Financial

Player must be registered with the full registration cost of \$50.⁰⁰ (non refundable) in order to participate in RSC. The registration fee covers basic medical insurance coverage, director of coaching fees, and administrative cost. Club annual fee is \$375.⁰⁰ which includes covering the cost of our two RSC indoor tournaments (The Winter Classic and Presidents Cup) and our one outdoor tournament (The Rushmore Cup). Entry fee costs to all club directed travel tournaments the RSC teams will participate in are charged to every rostered player on the team, regardless if they travel with the team or not. Exceptions to this will only be approved in extreme circumstances.

The total individual financial commitment for this team for the upcoming year is _____. This financial commitment () includes () excludes the Region II Cup tournament. The financial commitment may be met by personal funds or by participation in RSC fund raising activities. Financial commitment deadlines are as follows:

The estimated cost to a players account for travel averages between \$75 and \$100 per player per tournament trip. This includes lodging (to include coaches lodging), tournament fees, and transportation. The cost of meals, entertainment, and other personal expenses are additional and the responsibility of the individual player.

Time

The player will participate in the Presidents Cup and the Rushmore Cup as a fund raising activity and support their own team's fund raising activities.

The player is required to participate in a minimum of 75% of the team meetings, scheduled practices and "pre-tournament" games in order to qualify for tournament travel. This provision may be waived under certain circumstances or conditions by the coach.

Parents do become a member of the Parents Organization (included in your annual club fee) and are encouraged to participate in at least one (1) Parent Organization event, to serve as a committee member, officer, tournament organizer, etc., and/or travel room parent and/or assist the team as requested by the coach. If parents do not travel to tournaments, it is encouraged that they assume an active role in the Parents Organization or other RSC activities.

Code of Conduct

The player and parent/guardian must sign the player code of conduct attached hereto and agree to comply fully.

Damage/Property Liability

We agree that the cost/liability and acts that damage property or does bodily injury (outside the course of legal match play), or any loss of property or equipment owned or controlled by the RSC will be borne and rest upon the parent/guardian of the Player and the Player.
